Work, Knowledge & Skills

- Overview of outputs
 - HLFS: Survey of households, attachment to I/mkt
 - Supplements: Income, SoWL, h'hold ITC, childcare
 - QES: Business survey, I/mkt activity
 - LEED: Tax, linked employer-employee data
 - EOTE feasibility study
 - Student loans: linked MSD, MoE & Tax data
- Focus on unit record data, but some t/series maybe data available at more detail than published

Better access – unit record data

- Access to statistics is facilitated by the Stats Act
 - 37C: Disclosure of individual schedules to other Government Departments for bona fide research or statistical purposes
- CURFs: Confidential Unit Record Files
- Data lab: access via submission, and demonstrated research value
- Secondment: Available to government agency researchers and academics where research interests align with SNZ objectives

Types of access

- Make available a number of unit record data sets:
 - Qtly HLFS panels
 - Linked-Longitudinal HLFS
 - Supplement survey panels
 - LEED via secondment, and in the future likely access via data lab
